

# Chillagoe Cave Extension

Experience a taste of the outback and view the limestone caves. Chillagoe is still a mining town but the old smelter site has an interpretive trail. Walk the karst landscape while searching for birds and explore two caves with ranger guides.

The Hub provides information on the geological development of the area.

At night a tour of the night sky might be available at the observatory.

Alternatively search for reptiles at night. Huge geckoes inhabit the rocky outcrops.
